



Vocabulary Bingo

Purpose of the game: By repetition and in a game structure to encourage the memorization of key concepts in a unit of study.

1. During a unit of study, put up list of words covering key concepts. (Word bank?) The terms have been defined and are in student notebooks.
 2. Prepare bingo sheet with sufficient squares to insert all the words.
 3. Prepare a sheet of the terms and definitions as the key to final play and answers.
 4. Have students write the words into the bingo squares randomly
 5. Either the teacher, or a student, calls out definitions one at a time. Players cover, circle or highlight the appropriate term and call “bingo” when they have a column, row or diagonal filled.
 6. Winner must call back the word and a correct definition to claim the prize.
- Repeated play will ensure greater remembering.

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
