**ST. JOSEPH'S CATHOLIC WOMEN'S LEAGUE** will host a guest speaker at their monthly general meeting on Monday, on 13 February 2012, at 7:00 p.m. Guest speaker, Alison Bogle, is a teacher with the Algonquin & Lakeshore Catholic District School Board, will talk about her recent two week trip to Haiti to volunteer with Habitat for Humanity International. Two years ago, the island of Haiti was decimated by an earthquake. Last November, Alison traveled to Laogone, the epicentre of the earthquake, to join more than 500 others in an effort to build 150 homes in two weeks for the people of the community of Santo. The trip was a "Carter Build" which meant that volunteers were joined by President and Mrs. Carter, longtime supporters of efforts to rebuild Haiti for Haitians. Alison is eager to share her experiences with the Catholic Women's League and the greater community. The presentation will include a brief video/slide show. All are welcome to attend.
